TOP SLAP - Solar Lunar Action Period predicted for 10-12 July was verified in all key detail for predicted land events

Piers Corbyn's TOP SLAP for around 10-12 July was verified in general terms by a number of very extreme events around the world (inc Ghana, Nepal, **China**, S Australia, S America & Pacific Typhoon) and both the explicit detailed forecasts for land events were verified – for USA/Canada and for Britain/Ireland NW Europe.

1. For USA/Canada (Great Lakes etc) the forecast - (as on <http://www.weatheraction.com/docs/WANews10No25.pdf>):

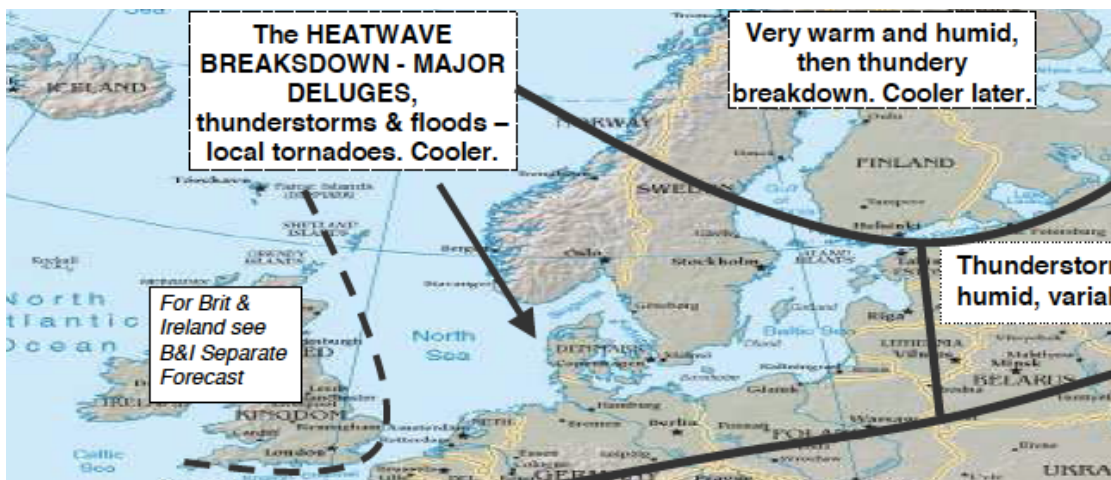
- JULY 9-11 (/10-12) TOP α, θ SLAP** (A=85% Confidence) TOP RED WARNING PERIOD
- MidWest / Great Lakes / S Michigan - Hail, tornadoes floods – repeat of type of weather last period.

2. For Britain / Ireland & NW Europe the forecast was confirmed by events

For the connected NW Europe development the explicit detailed forecast of the Heatwave and its timing and manner of breakdown was predicted and confirmed. The map below is an extract from WeatherAction 30day Europe maps detailed forecast issued 27 June via

There are many reports of the forecasted heatwave and its breakdown which verified the forecast but of special interest were reports of exceptionally extreme weather involving two tornadoes in the forecasted likely region and time period:-

a) Three people were killed by 'howling black-wall storms' in NW Germany / Heligoland which included a tornado 12 July afternoon
