For Britain/Ireland & Europe Piers's forecast (right) for the main **Thundery deluges and flash floods** to be concentrated in central & NW parts of Britain / Ireland has been dramatically confirmed in detail.

<p><b>18-23 JULY 2010 BC = 70%</b>          As 45d, a bit wetter than 30-80d</p>
<p>Solar Factors: <b>TOP a SLAP 18-20 Major</b>  <b>Δ 8 SLAP around 23 RED WARNING.</b></p>
<p>Likely possible weather map scenario:          Deep active low pressure (prob a sub-low of main low to West of Iceland) drives across Central / South Ireland &amp; Britain into continent / South Baltic. A ridge builds over West of Ireland later.</p>
<p>Thundery deluges &amp; flash floods (especially 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup> &amp; 22<sup>nd</sup>/23<sup>rd</sup>), bright periods at times, cool</p>  <p>Variable thundery showers (espec 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup> &amp; 22<sup>nd</sup>/23<sup>rd</sup>) &amp; bright periods.</p>
<p><b>Major thundery deluges and torrential rain</b> – prob in two waves – with hail &amp; tornadoes likely &amp; widespread flash <b>FLOODS</b> espec 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup> &amp; 22<sup>nd</sup>/23<sup>rd</sup>.</p>
