

Cool end July B+I Standard Met 14 d ahead (GFS) NOW agrees with WeatherAction 44 d ahead (from WA choices 140d ahead)

“Heatwave to last a month” blazed The Express (bel) 13 July. Then on 15th The Independent (of reality!): “Extreme (hot) summers *are* growing more common”. This mentally defective claim is negated by the reality that 5 of the last 6 summers were floody & mostly cold – as we forecast and the opposite of MetO promised ‘BBQ summers’. Amusingly as the Press rolled standard Met GFS models (bel) projected late/end-month maps very similar to the WeatherAction view made mid June. “Models change a lot and include cold before the 30th (below) - supporting our cool/cold late/end July forecast”, said Piers Corbyn.

SLAT 9 is born

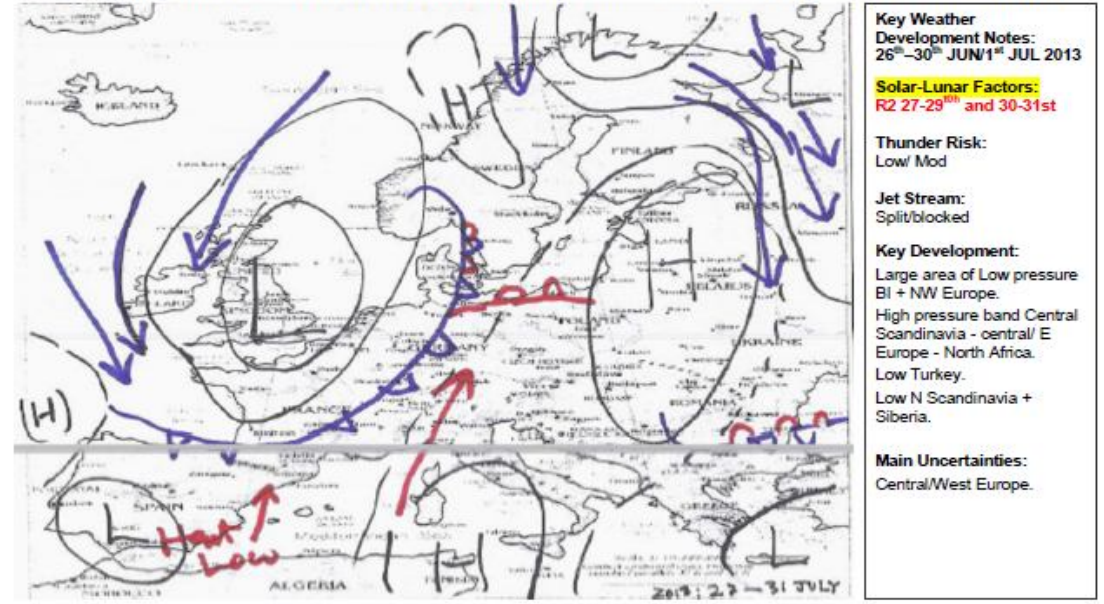

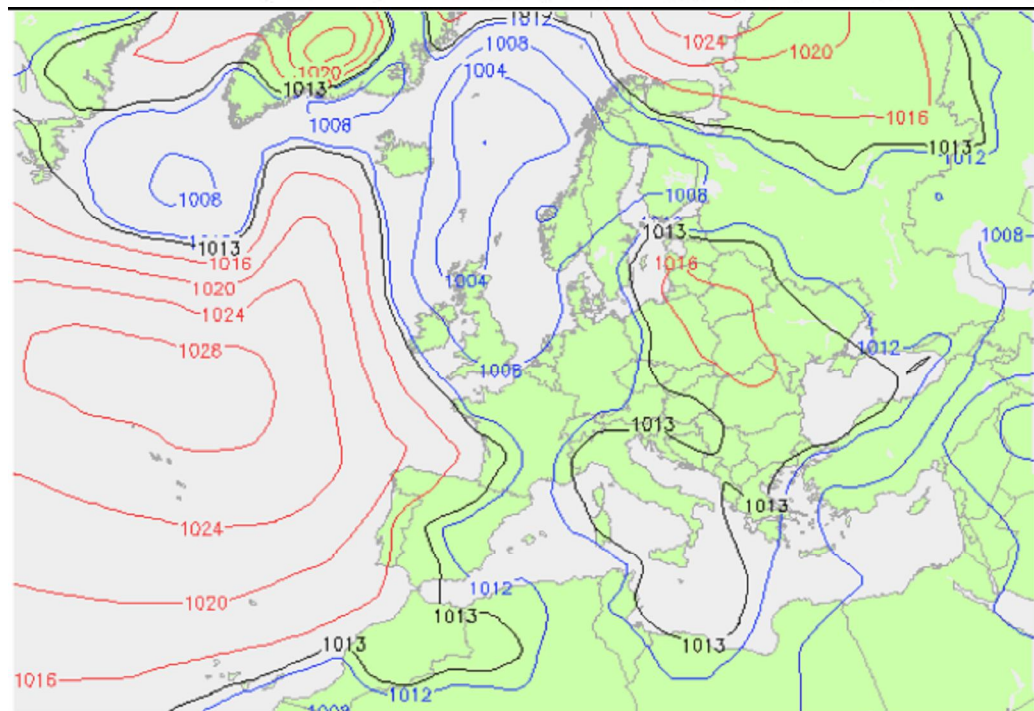


Europe Possible Pressure Scenario Map SLAT 8C JULY 2013 for: 27th – 31st July. Confidence: B = 75%
From Forecast Pressure Maps choices first made 12th Mar. Timing to 1 day. Likely success rate of weather periods is 8 or 9 basically successful out of every 10
