## 3rd Comm (27Oct early morning) THE "END GAME" Track of OUR "THE BIG ONE" in R5 27-30<sup>th</sup> **YES! LATEST STANDARD Model Sun 27<sup>th</sup> 0z Confirms Weather-Action shift of storm centre track somewhat South (+ moving faster)**

• AS shown in previous information Storm Centre positions in SouthWest approaches were very similar in WeatherAction 6 week ahead and MetO 2day ahead

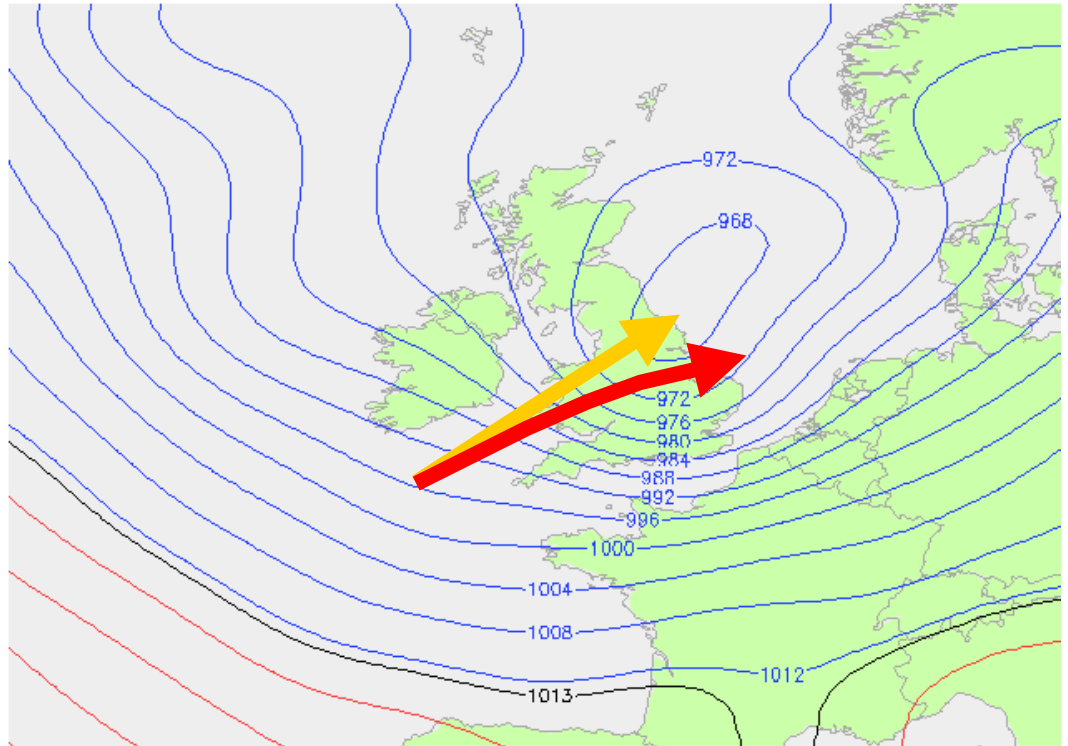
• WeatherAction 2<sup>nd</sup> update information (issued 26<sup>TH</sup> 04.30) stated Storm Centre positions would likely shift south from **Yellow track** to **Red** during R5 period (27-30<sup>th</sup>) – copied as below

The **yellow line** shows MO model storm centre track to Mon 28<sup>th</sup> 12 noon possibility and our **red arrow** shows how such would likely be perturbed by the R5. This is **one** likely trial option for research purposes and interest – the differences could be more or less.

We notice over the last few days the MO warnings of top wind strengths has increased whereas WeatherAction SLAT9A (Solar-Lunar-Action-Technique) said - one forecast only from 6 weeks ago - **severe gale & storm force winds in Ireland, S/W Britain+ N/W France with high likelihood of some tornadoes during 27-30<sup>th</sup> and "Extremely DANGEROUS" seas**

We did not say then if that meant storm 10 or 11 and now say **STORM FORCE 11 IS LIKELY ON LAND IN PLACES which given the tornado risk can mean Hurricane 12 as well and with the wider coverage track of this storm puts this total storm damage on a par with the Great Storm of Oct 15 1987, 26 yrs ago.**

Surface Pressure GFS (hPa)

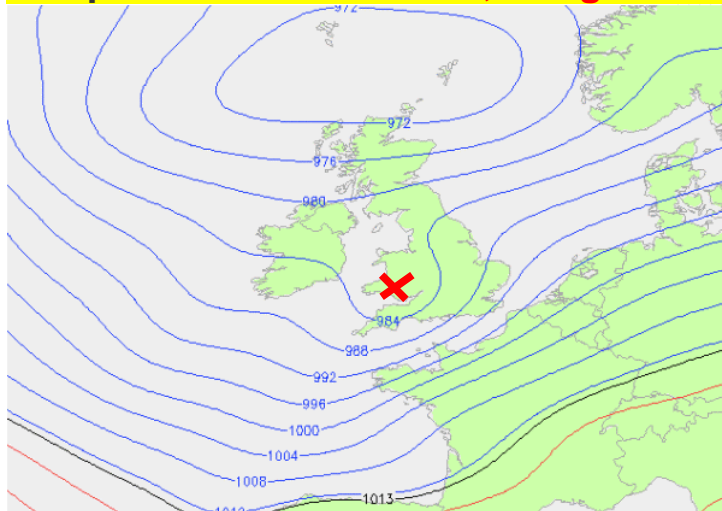

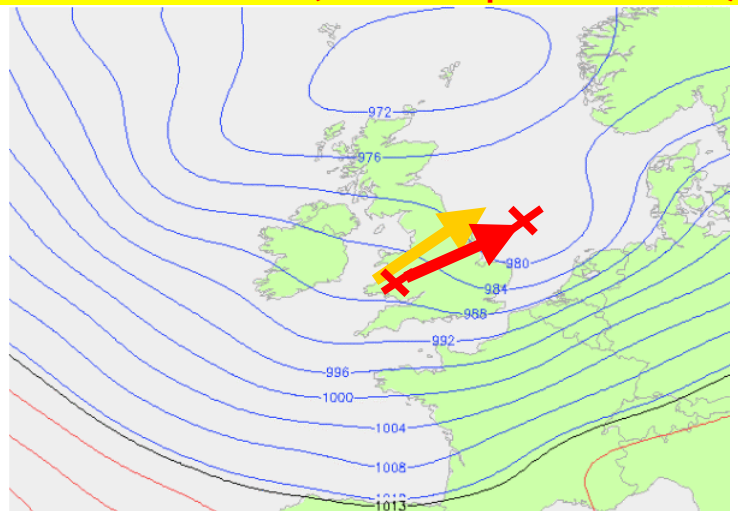
• **Expect More shift South, ~Anglia & winds STRONGER (close to but prob less than '87)**
