A 'strong' application of the new (Solar-Lunar-Action-Technique) SLAT12 was found to be generally good in past checks so this was applied to the period 12-15<sup>th</sup> April. This gives a much more unsettled result for Br+Ir and NW Europe (inc Scandinavia) than the 45d issue.

## 12-15 APRIL 2015

Confidence B 75%

**Special SLAT 12S** update forecast produced 3/4<sup>th</sup> April, **graph inserted** later (6<sup>th</sup>)

**Wet and windy, major thunderstorms and large hail, high tornado risk. Turning cloudy and very cool / cold. Possibly wintry on high ground in N/W.**

**Solar Factors: R4 12-15th**

**Thunder/Tornado risk** very high

**Winds:** SW'ly becoming cyclonic gales in places in N/W

**Temps:** - turning colder than normal in all parts.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Developments:**

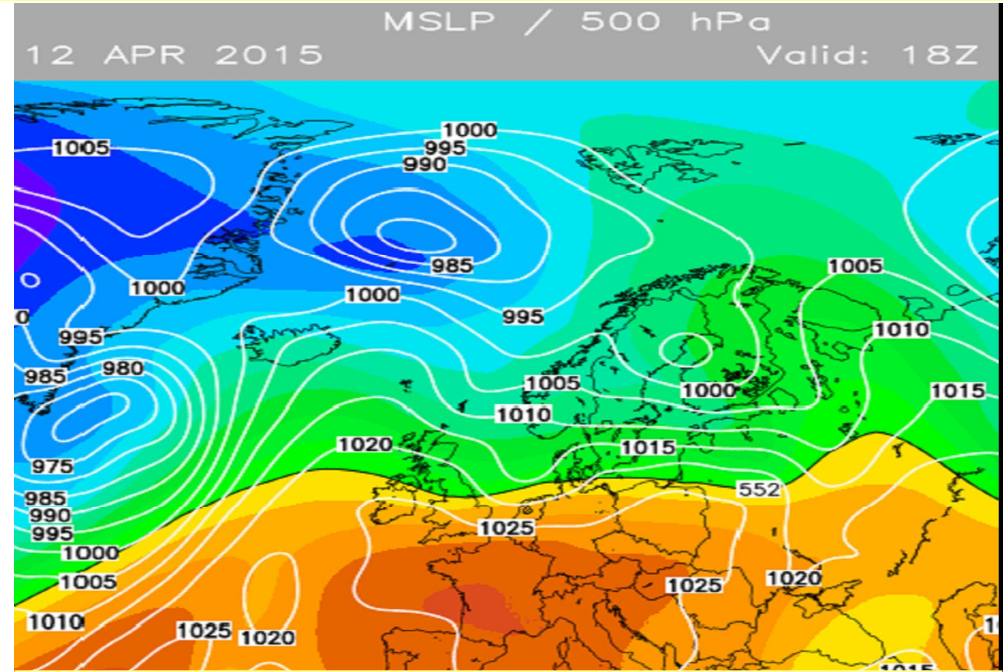
High pressure pushed East as deep active low attacks Ire + Britain and tracks through most of Britain (Cyclonic). Fronts penetrate parts of NW Europe including West Scandinavia (see Euro 30d forecasts)

*Possibly wintry snow/sleet on high ground in N/W*

Becoming wet and windy with major thunderstorms and large hail. Becoming cloudy and cold in prob all parts.

Piers Corbyn says: "Our important SLAT12 update for B+I & NW Europe for ~12-15 April is being confirmed. The dramatic change from dry sunny and warm over all B+I in original SLAT11 forecast to a wet and windy incursion from a Low coming from West giving wintry snow/sleet on high ground in N/W is observed.

-See P+Temp Map and Jet Stream map - cold plunge from North (lower Right).

-The initial extent to the South is maybe less /slower than the update but **the fundamental change and contrast is here**. This is important for future forecast advances and developments to many month ahead forecasts over the world.
