 South track but more normal than before.

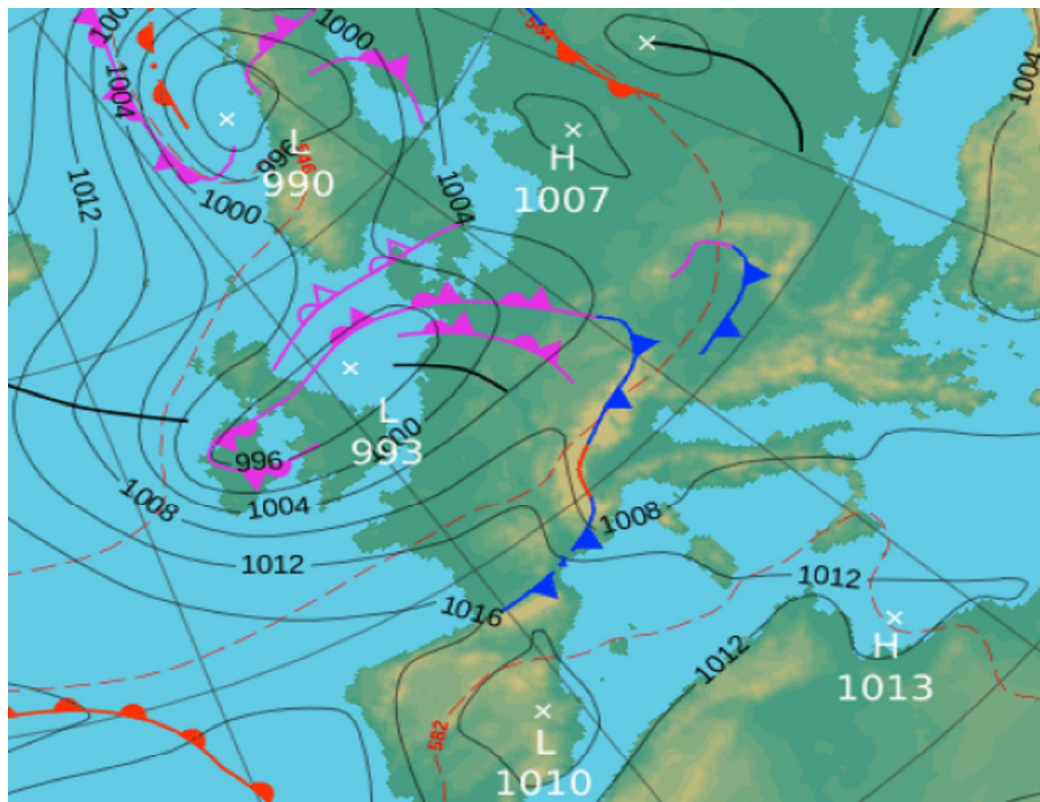
**Key Development:**  
 Iceland HIGH.  
 Cyclonic Low attacks Ireland-Britain from West and its centre passes into Ireland and then Wales-England / N sea and Scandinavia.  
 High North Scandinavia + west Russia.  
 Azores High extends to (N) Spain.  
 Heat LowS Spain.  
 Lows E Med / Black Sea.

**Main Uncertainties:**  
 Timings unsure.

# Late July cold blast on cue

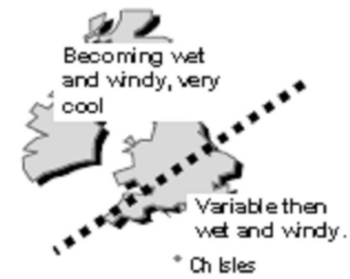
WeatherAction Br+Ire Long-Range forecast cold blast late July is confirmed with forecast maps (left) and graphs issued end June becoming reality. Standard computer model forecasts issued at start month suggested ongoing warmth later and failed totally to identify the **cold end which is important for agriculture, gardening and business.**

**Turning wet and windy in most parts, cool.**  
 CHANGE from 45d. NewR4 27-28<sup>h</sup> not in 75d/45d



Winds: SW'ly then cyclonic becoming N'ly  
 Temps: cool in Ireland + most England, Scot+N/E cold later  
 Sky: becoming cloudy  
 Solar Factors R4 27-28<sup>h</sup>

Likely possible weather map scenario:  
 Cyclonic Low attacks Ireland-Britain from West and its centre passes into Ireland and then Wales-England / N sea. Azores High extends to (N) Spain. Lows central Med - Black Sea.  
 Jet Stream: South track
